## Skill displayed

You are able to respond to the question in a relevant way and say what you know or learn about character/setting/action/relationship/atmosphere.

You are able to say what your evidence for this is.

You are able to embed and introduce the evidence.

You are able to say <u>how</u> you know by naming a technique/method or identifying a key word.

You are able to say <u>how</u> this technique or word creates meaning and you analyse the effect.

You are able to say why it has been used.

You comment on  $\underline{\text{how}}$  the use of this method reinforces your point.

Extension: you are able to double up on techniques

## How to improve - complete one of these tasks as part of your reflection and improvement

Go back to your initial point and re/write it. Ensure it is relevant and clear. Have you demonstrated that you know what is being shown?

Choose a better quotation - ensure it is relevant and you have a lot to say about it.

Go back and introduce the quote: who, what, where, when, to who, why.

Add more analysis by showing that you understand <u>how</u> meaning is created through this technique. Discuss the effect of the technique/method you name.

Add more analysis by showing that you understand <u>how</u> meaning is created through language. Discuss the effect of language choices and their connotations.

Add more detail about <u>what</u> is shown with regards to character/setting/action/relationship/atmosphere through the use of technique or language. Name the method used.

Add an explanation of why this method was used in this way:

<u>Why</u> does the writer want to show you this? <u>Why</u> does the writer want you to feel/understand this? <u>Why</u> did the writer choose this particular technique? <u>Why</u> was it used at this particular point in the text?

How does the use of this method reinforce your point?
